Course Description

This one day seminar discusses the latest information on stroke diagnosis and treatment. The lecture begins with a review of neuroanatomy and the blood supply to the brain and spinal cord. A comprehensive overview of modifiable and non-modifiable risk factors and the treatment and prevention of the modifiable risk factors for both hemorrhagic and ischemic strokes will be provided. The lecture will focus on the classic clinical presentation for both hemorrhagic and ischemic strokes. An acute neuro exam for the patient presenting to an emergency room with possible stroke symptoms will be demonstrated, and the neuro exam for the patient with chronic stroke signs and symptoms will be discussed. Acute emergency treatment for hemorrhagic and ischemic strokes will be discussed as will chronic treatment protocols. Contact hours will be available for nurses who have not previously taken this course. Your active involvement is required in order to complete the course and to ensure a dynamic learning experience.

Course Objectives

Upon completion of the course, participants will be able to:

1. Discuss the risk factors for hemorrhagic and ischemic strokes.
2. Differentiate the signs and symptoms that distinguish hemorrhagic from ischemic strokes.
3. Discuss the anterior and posterior vascular supply of the brain and brainstem.
4. Correlate the functional neuroanatomy of the brain as it relates to the vascular supply.
5. List the various treatment modalities for acute hemorrhagic and ischemic strokes.
6. Discuss the post-acute management of patients with hemorrhagic and ischemic strokes.
7. Understand the numerous measures that can be taken to prevent strokes.
